PASTOR'S CORNER

I am looking forward to our time together over the next year or so in this time of for transition. I must say that I am impressed with Grace Presbyterian Church on numerous levels, from your sacred worship to your people of faith, from your commitment to serve, to your hospitality. I see nothing but good things ahead. My job as a transitional pastor is different than a called pastor, for a transitional pastor is usually a short term, between one and two years. We have a lot of work ahead of us as we prepare for your next called pastor. I believe my experience both as a pastor for 20+ years and as a lay person for that same amount of time give me adequate grounding for this position as a Certified Transitional Pastor (CTP). Having served as a member of the Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC) I know the pains of sorting through PIF's and the struggles one has as you anticipate your next called pastor.

This church reminds me of the first church I served in the city of Dubuque, IA. The church there was unique in that several Professors and their families from the University of Dubuque Theological Seminary and local colleges attended. The core members were from the community and were lifetime members. The Dubuque Church of just under 100 members was making a transition to a full-time pastor after having a part-time pastor for twenty years.

We are fortunate to be in a denomination that is ahead of the game in making the CTP position a priority,

over a third of ECO's pastors will be retiring in the next 5 to 10 years. The training I have received both from ECO and Interim Ministry Network gives me some valuable tools to help access and give direction to the situation here at Grace Presbyterian Church. As a CTP I will be guiding and helping Grace Church evaluate your present situation and determine God's call in the future.

One way to look at the position of a CTP is like that of John the Baptist preparing the way for Jesus to come. At our last Presbytery meeting of the Upper Midwest, a CTP made this same comparison. He made it clear, no I am not saying I am John the Baptist, nor is your next pastor going to be Jesus. However, the job John the Baptist had in preparing the way for the One to come is similar. Also, at the given time John knew he would need to step down and the focus would then be on Jesus. In much the same way my job as a CTP will be completed, and God willing you will be ready for your next called pastor. Yes, it may take some time for Dawn and I to adjust to the ways of the south, but so far, we are finding Conway and Arkansas both very welcoming. I firmly believe God will bless our time together. *"Therefore, the Lord waits and longs to be gracious to you, and therefore he waits on high to have compassion on you. For the Lord is a God of justice; blessed are all those who long for Him."* (Isaiah 30: 18 AMP)



- ◆ The committee approved participating in the "Angel Tree" program again this year. More information will be coming out on this opportunity as it becomes available.
- ◆ We participate in Conway's Adopt a Street Program and seven GPC Covenant Partners gathered at the Church Saturday morning, October 30th, to pick-up litter along six tenths of a mile of Prince Street from Hogan Lane to Reedy Road. Six bags of litter and 3 golf balls were collected.
- ◆ As part of our continuing support of the Conway Ministry Center we purchased supplies and packed 100 snack packs for their distribution daily to the homeless in our community. That represented a one week supply. The Ministry Center will continue passing out snack packs through November 19th. For the past several years the Ministry Center has operated a overnight "Winter Warming Center" in Conway. At this date this needed service is in doubt due to the lack of a facility. If anyone is aware of a facility that might be used for this purpose the Ministry Center would very much like to hear from you, or you can let a member of this committee know.
